Table of contents. Generating a table of contents can be done with a few simple commands. LaTeX will use the section headings to create the table of contents and there are commands to create a list of figures and a list of tables as well. I will give a small example code to create a table of contents first:

Generate a table of contents in LaTeX

Sections, subsections and chapters are included in the table of contents. To manually add entries, for example when you want an unnumbered section, use the command `\addcontentsline` as shown in the example. Note: For the table of contents to work properly you must compile the document twice or use `latexmk -pdf` Open an example in Overleaf

Table of contents - Overleaf, Online LaTeX Editor

LaTeX uses a defined space for entries in the table of contents, which means that long chapter or section numbers sometimes overlap the title. One easy solution is to override this by adding `\renewcommand {\numberline} {\#1~}` to the preamble. Using a dedicated package for ToC customization might be better, though.

LaTeX/Tables of Contents and Lists of Figures - Wikibooks ...

Creating content lists in LaTeX documents is straight forward. Typing these three commands is sufficient to produce a toc, lof, and lot. To produce the lists, the document has to be typeset twice. The first iteration collects all headings and captions and writes them to meta files (*.toc, *.lof, *.lot).

LaTeX table of contents, list of figures/tables and some ...

The table of contents includes all headlines in the document. Its depth is therefore the same as the headline levels in the file. If you need to use a different depth, or turn it off entirely, set the `org-export-with-toc` variable accordingly.

Table of Contents (The Org Manual)

If you wish to add a line to your table of contents (for example, your References section, if you've written one manually), you can use the `\addcontentsline` command described on page 159 of the LaTeX manual. In short, its syntax is as follows: `\addcontentsline {file} {section_unit} {entry}`

Selecting either Automatic Table 1 or 2 will create the table of contents using the names of the headings. If you chose the "Manual Table" option from the "Table of Contents" drop-down menu, then it will insert a template for you that you will need to edit yourself. You may notice in this table of contents that there are sub-levels.

In the first case, adding `heading=bibintoc` adds the title to the table of contents as an unnumbered chapter if possible or as an unnumbered section otherwise. The second case is `heading=subbibintoc` that adds the title as a second level entry in the table of contents, in this example as a subsection nested in "Whole bibliography".
